Paper title: "From Learning to Earning: Investigating the Role of Social Media in Education and Employment for English Education Graduates of Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Banten"

This study explores social media's role in education and employment for the fresh graduates of English Education Department (TBI) of Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Banten. The massive advancement of social media has shifted some people's ways of life, including the way individuals acquire knowledge and occupation. It becomes a pivotal tool in broadening access to information, educational resources, and career opportunities. A mix-method was employed in this study by conducting interviews and surveys. 14 participants graduated from the English Education Department of UIN Banten were involved in the data collection on how the use of social media to foster learning, builds professional networks, and enhance relevant skills in labor markets.
